1/8/01 -- Happy New Year everyone!! It looks like we made it at least somewhat intact into the New Millennium!

I am very proud to announce that in December, I was awarded the title **Associate Magi Astrologer** by the **Magi Society!** Since this title is only awarded for a certain level of accomplishment in both basic and Magi Astrology, I was and am deeply honored.

Magi Astrology specializes in the astrology of **relationships, business and finance**, and the **selection of auspicious days** to commence important activities. The first day we do something creates the "birth chart" for that thing-- is it any surprise that **Microsoft, Dell Computer, and Wal-Mart** were incorporated on excellent days? Or that the wedding dates of **Colin Powell, Tom Hanks, and Tom Cruise/ Nicole Kidman**, were outstanding? Or that the release dates of **Gone with the Wind** and the original **Star Wars** were nearly perfect? The Magi Society's formulas for success in love and money are based upon the statistical computer analysis of hundreds of thousands of charts of individuals and major events, and can be applied when choosing our own wedding, incorporation and release dates for maximum good fortune.

Our first **Full Moon of the New Year is Tuesday Jan. 9 at 12:24 pm PST**, accompanied by a **total Lunar Eclipse at 19° Cancer**. The Capricorn Sun- Cancer Full Moon exemplifies a split between head and heart, career and home. We may feel impelled to make some changes in these areas-- especially those of us born near the 7th - 13th of January, the 6th - 11th of April, the 8th - 14th of July, the 9th - the 15th of October, and any of us with planets near 19-20° in the cardinal signs of Aries, Cancer, Libra, and Capricorn. With the Full Moon in emotional Cancer, we could experience our feelings deeply, with the possibility of hypersensitivity and the need to retreat. A walk on the beach, or some natural sea salt in our bath or hot tub might be especially soothing.

Our new year **New Moon on Wed. 1/24 at 5:07 am PST in Aquarius conjunct Neptune** is concurrent with **Saturn turning direct again at 24° Taurus at 4:24 pm PST**, and the **Chinese New Year, as we enter the Year of the Snake**. Then, the next day on **Thurs. 1/25, Jupiter goes direct at 1° Gemini at 12:39 am PST**. This is a lot of activity at the end of Taurus and beginning of Gemini, and those with planets in this area of the zodiac will probably notice it most. With Neptune a player in the lunation, we may find dreams and fantasies playing a stronger than usual role in our outlook for the month. However, we should be at least somewhat back in business, with Jupiter and Saturn going direct as we enter the domain of the practical, wily, resourceful, and persevering Snake. But we should not expect the grand scale of the Dragon year which preceded it-- we'll probably see more cautious growth, and shouldn't tempt the fates too much-- the Snake is much less forgiving than the magnanimous Dragon.

We have 3 weeks to get important papers, business, etc. handled before **Mercury goes retrograde again on 2/3 at 5:55 pm PST through 7:42 am PST on 2/25**. As always, Mercury retrograde can create foul-ups with communication, computers, and travel. The only real solutions are preparation, taking time to triple check spelling, figures, and wording, being extra clear with verbal agreements and arrangements, and *patience*.

Remember, **Moon Void** is not a good time to attempt anything important -- **Moon Void times for the next month lasting an hour or more during the business day (more or less) are Tues. 1/16 4:35 am -11:02 am PST, Tues. 1/23 7:38 am -7:43 pm PST, Fri. 1/26 12:28 am- 11:39 am EST, Fri. 2/2 2:31 am- 12:56 pm PST, and Tues. 2/6 9:30 am- 4:21 pm PST**. We're lucky, we don't have too many this month!

"When the moon is in the 7th house, and Jupiter aligns with Mars, then peace will guide the planets, and love will steer the stars....." We grew up with these lyrics, but this (+ or -) really is the **dawning of the Age of Aquarius--** the "New Age." We are now passing out of the Age of Pisces, which began about 2,000 years ago. (Yes, the Earth passes retrograde through the Zodiacal Wheel.) Each Age, or "Great Year," lasts approximately 2000 years, and seems to correlate closely to its Zodiacal symbolism. The Age of Taurus, approx. 4000 - 2000 BC was known for its agriculture and love of beauty and luxury- (and the beginning of Minoan civilization- featuring *bull-leaping*). The Age of Aries (bold, pioneering, fearless) approx. 2000 BC- 0 AD brought the Indo-European invaders sweeping in from the North and the cult of the Amazons.
