<u>2/25/02--</u> <u>Full Moon is Wednesday 2/27 at 1:17 am PST</u>. The Full Moon across the Virgo-Pisces axis highlights the polarity of matter versus spirit, detail versus oneness. With Mercury just separating from eclipse with Neptune (both conjunct and parallel) in Aquarius, and also parallel with Chiron we will probably choose transcendent and romantic values over practical ones at this time. Do keep your eye on the ball, though.

The "Heartbreak Transit"- (Saturn in an applying quincunx to Chiron in geo)- continues through 3/9/02.

Please, please, please try very hard not to start anything new during this time, for business or for pleasure. Try your best not to meet anyone new, especially if they could be important. Don't make love with someone for the first time, and especially, don't marry. Don't sign papers, start a new job, incorporate, or anything else. It's crucial not to start a chart for any new relationship or endeavor with this aspect-- it's well-named---- and none of us need more heartbreak.

Noteworthy <u>Magi Days</u> this month: (These are days whose planetary patterns suggest strong general tendencies for one and all.) <u>3/13-</u> A day to say good-bye- be sure not to provoke it if that's not what you have in mind. <u>3/21-</u> Great for both love and business until 7:00 pm PST- try to get in some of both.

New Moon is 3/13 at 6:03 pm PST. Sun and Moon in Pisces along with Mercury, and square the nodes, may indicate a continuing preference for fantasy over the details of living, especially with the Sun parallel Venus. But focus is the direction we need to take, as indicated by the North Node. With Venus, Mars and Chiron in close degrees to one another, romance is certainly highlighted, but sexual performance may be restrained by the Mars-Neptune square and Saturn lurking nearby degree-wise. Enjoy the good times, but get your work done too.

<u>Pluto goes retrograde 3/20- 8/26.</u> Most of the outer planets appear retrograde throughout every summer. We might see some delays in changes and transformations during this time. (See further discussion of retrogrades below.)

The <u>Saturn- Pluto opposition continues in helio through 3/30</u>---- surely there's more we can let go of as the grudging purification continues.... and the less we grudge the clearing out process the more we can bless and release with gratitude and love...... remember that letting go is so much easier than having something taken.... and <u>always remember that nothing is</u> <u>ever taken from us that we need for our soul growth</u>. I have written extensively about the Saturn-Pluto opposition in the last 6 or 7 newsletters- its difficulties and the beautiful opportunities it offers us to make everything in our lives a more authentic reflection of our truest selves and a better platform for our evolutionary process--- <u>If you would like to receive this information again, please don't hesitate to ask-----</u>

Answers to few questions from readers:

I never thought quincunx was a very strong aspect.

I base my use of the quincunx as a major aspect on the research of the Magi Society, who after computer analysis of hundreds of thousands of charts, concluded that it had a major influence.

I don't understand what is "Chiron in geo."

As do all astrologers studying Magi Astrology, I use both geocentric (geo) and heliocentric (helio) calculations. This means that I am using the standard geocentric (as viewed from Earth) chart, but also, the much less commonly used geocentric declinations, the heliocentric (as viewed from the Sun) latitudes, and the heliocentric longitudes. So basically I (and the Magi Society) use 4 dimensions of astrology instead of the 1 dimension normally used. I was also wondering, what are the general affects of Jupiter in retrograde, and are they as strong as say a Mercury retrograde influence.

I do give some credence to retrogrades, but since there is no such thing in the heliocentric sky I don't give them the importance that I once did. Retrogrades can create less easy flow in the matters ruled by the planet, most of which is rectified once the planet goes direct again. Since Jupiter rules growth, wisdom, benevolence, good luck, protection, abundance or too much, optimism, and general helpfulness, a Jupiter retrograde may symbolize some delays in these areas. Since retrogrades of the

more outer planets last longer than Mercury retrogrades, it is possible that their effects are less easily felt by comparison. **Jupiter goes direct 3/1 at 7:15 am PST.**

I was wondering when the best time to try and have a baby was?

The most blessed time to try to conceive is during a Jupiter-Chiron conjunction, trine, quincunx, parallel, or contraparallel in either the geo or helio, because it enhances fertility and brings in a child who is a pride and joy to the family.

Remember, Moon Void is not a good time to attempt anything important—Moon Void times for the next 30 days lasting an hour or more during the business day (more or less) are 2/26 8:30 am- 11:47 am PST, 2/27 7:17 pm- 2/28 10:46 am PST, 3/4 6:43 am- 1:55 pm PST, 3/8 7:06 am- 3/9 6:56 am PST, 3/11 11:28 am- 6:56 pm PST, 3/13 6:03 pm- 3/14 7:34 am PST, 3/19 4:53 am- 7:20 am PST, and 3/21 10:14 am- 4:06 pm PST. Don't forget to adjust for your time zone, and that the Moon is also void other days and times and/or for shorter periods...
