Full Moon is Mon. 6/24 at 2:42 pm PDT. There's no rest for the weary at this Full Moon, with Saturn still conjunct North Node opposite Pluto conjunct South Node. We're still dredging up the past while bearing heavy burdens in the now. We should have plenty of energy, though, with Mars conjunct Jupiter. Venus opposite Neptune might restrict creativity or romance a bit, though with the magic rectangle of Mercury, Venus, Pluto and Neptune it shouldn't be much of a problem. There are not any significant applying aspects today in helio, with the exception of the continuing Earth/Moon Complex - Neptune parallel which lasts for more than a year more. This very benevolent Universal Transit continues to help prop up the economy and consumer confidence, as well as boost our romantic feelings.

July 4 looks to be a mixed holiday. In geo, Mercury, Saturn, Mars, Jupiter, and Venus in equal degree aspect, and Mars parallel Jupiter and Saturn feels fairly energetic, friendly and chatty, even with the Saturn involvement, but Sun parallel Mercury and Saturn could restrict good feelings and communication. Sun quincunx Pluto makes us all feel invincible, anyway- which could create some temporary self-esteem imbalances. Venus square Mars in helio, along with the Saturn stuff in geo, make this a bad day for starting anything new- especially romantically.

New Moon is 7/10 at 3:26 am PDT. This New Moon begins to lighten things up a bit overall, with Saturn and Pluto moving away from the Nodal Axis. It doesn't appear to be a great month for romance though, with Venus opposite Uranus and Mercury opposite Chiron in geo. We want our space and can't find the diplomatic and loving words to explain ourselves. Sun parallel Jupiter and Saturn give us plenty of power, Venus contraparallel Uranus and Pluto makes us feel sexy but increases our desire to make changes within our relationship, or chuck it and move on. In helio, Earth/Moon Complex quincunx Saturn and Venus square Neptune also make loving more problematic. If things are basically good, make whatever changes are necessary within the relationship, but stay put and wait this stuff out.

As you have requested, here is a brief **Glossary of Astrological Terms** you'll see used in StarGazer:

Applying- two or more planets moving toward making an exact aspect.

Aspect- a mathematical relationship between 2 planets- usually in 30° increments.

Conjunct or Conjunction- two or more planets within 3° of each other in the sky.

Contraparallel- two or more planets at the same degree in the declinations or latitudes, but on opposite sides of the celestial equator.

Declinations- the vertical orientation of the planets by degree in geo.

Earth/Moon Complex- the Earth together with the Moon as viewed from the Sun.

Geocentric or Geo- the planets as viewed from the Earth.

Heliocentric or Helio- the planets as viewed from the Sun.

Latitudes- the vertical orientation of the planets by degree in helio.

Longitudes- the horizontal, circular orientation of the planets in geo or helio.

Moon Void or Moon Void-Of-Course- times when the Moon has made its last aspect in one sign, and before it makes its first aspect in the next sign.

Orb- the amount of "fudge factor" allowed outside of an exact aspect. I use a 3° orb in longitudes, a 1.2° orb in declinations, and a 0.3° orb in latitudes.

Parallel- two or more planets at the same degree in the declinations or latitudes on the same side of the celestial equator.

Quincunx- a 150° aspect between planets.

Separating- two or more planets moving away from each other after making an exact aspect.

Square- a 90° aspect between planets.

Trine- a 120° aspect between planets.

Remember, **Moon Void** is not a good time to attempt anything important-- **Moon Void times for the next 30 days lasting an hour or more during the business day (more or less) are 6/24 6:38 am- 9:01 am PDT, 6/26 12:37 am- 3:36 pm PDT, 6/30 10:43 pm- 7/1 12:49 pm PDT, 7/8 4:37 pm- 7:36 pm PDT, 7/17 3:58 am- 7:13 am PDT, and 7/19 7:35 am- 11:02 am PDT.** Don't forget to adjust for your time zone, and that the Moon is also void other days and times and/or for shorter periods...
